A Handicapped Match Play Event

Rules of the Competition:

Match Play - All tournament play is to be by USGA rules. Local rules apply.

Tees - Players will choose which tees to play before each match. If the two parties cannot agree on which tees to use, a coin flip will determine the tees played.

Handicaps - Competitors shall use GHIN handicap indexes, current at the time of their match.

Tee Times - Players will arrange their own tee times for each match.

Requirements for Completion of Matches - First round matches MUST be completed within three (3) weeks of the March 6th start, or by March 27th. All subsequent matches MUST be completed within 2 weeks of the previous bracket's deadline. Any match not played within the allotted time frame will be scheduled by the tournament committee for the weekend following the deadline. If only one participant makes the tee time he/they will be declared the winner, if neither player/team make the tee time then both are DISQUALIFIED.

UNSURE HOW TO PROCEED? - If you are unsure how to proceed during the course of your match, you must clearly state your specific claim to your opponent prior to teeing off from the next teeing ground. That claim must then be filed with the Tournament Committee immediately preceding the match for resolution. Refer to USGA Rule 2-5.

Knuth System - We are now using a modified Knuth system to help promote fairness of play and help protect the integrity of the club and its members. We reserve the right to adjust any person's handicap based on the recommendation of this system. Posting Rules for WSGC Match Play Events -

- All competitors must turn in attested scorecards to the pro shop at the completion of their match. Both competitors must sign the card.
- Both competitors must record scores in the computer before leaving the golf course.

- Scores must be recorded as follows:
 1. Indicate the number of strokes on each hole for both competitors.
 2. If one competitor picks up on a hole, post the most likely score on that hole. Make sure you adjust this to an ESC score before you record your score. Indicate the hole on which the match is closed out.
 3. Scores after match close out will be posted at par plus handicap.
 4. The tournament committee will review the scores from match play events. Failure to comply with these rules in WSGC match play will result in disqualification.
 5. The purpose of this rule is to promote fair and open competition and to insure that scores are properly recorded in match play tournaments.
