### **Pending Work and Improvements -**

Trees around the lower 18th tee will be limbed up soon, if not by the time of this meeting.

The earthen dam that between the cart path at 13 and the gully needs to be cut down for inspection by officials. This shouldn't result in the loss of any significant trees.

**Pithium Update** - Overall, John is positive about the comeback. 1, 9, and 18 greens, as well as the practice greens are looking better and better as the summer progresses. Preventative measures are ongoing, including regular monitoring of a critical relationship between temperature and humidity (when they add up to over 150 pithium can become a problem).
